The idea was to keep people playing during the summer and to meet new people. There were 13 couples in the mixed doubles league. Teams scheduled matches with other teams in their division – and played in the morning, at night, on the weekends, etc. – whenever 4 people could find a time to all play at the same time. The tennis was a challenge – but scheduling was the real challenge! Rod and Brenda played in all kinds of conditions, including hot, very hot, very, very hot, windy, and stormy.

Rod and Brenda ended with an 8-1 record and the number 1 seed for the championship matches. The number 2 and 3 teams played each other, and Rod and Brenda played the winner of that match. The number 2 team, Keith and Sunny, won the match, defeating Austin and Rachel. Rod and Brenda were scheduled to play Keith and Sunny on August 21st and started the match, but due to lightning in the area, they rescheduled the match to August 30th. Rod and Brenda won 7-6 and 6-4 to become the Surprise Summer Flex League – Division 1 Mixed Doubles Champions!
