


A Big Thank you to Joel Plaskowski for helping PCTC with the organization and set-up of the PASS participants.

Since her childhood, she has been a "cat lover" by dressing them up in doll clothes and taking them out for walks.


Look for Debbie on the tennis or pickleball courts, and she is in the gym almost every day.
